FAQ for *Evidence of Grace*

What is the StartZone?

This booklet is an introduction to T&T and it is completed before the child received his/her book.

Why are all the kids working together rather than at their own pace like in Sparks?

Awana is starting to employ an “All Together” method, meaning all the kids work together on the same section during small group time. This year, T&T *Evidence of Grace* will be using the “All Together” method.

How should we prepare for Awana each week?

Ideally, each child will come prepared with the short Bible study completed and the verse memorized. The group will be working through these items together. If your child isn't prepared, it's fine! Everyone is welcome to come and learn together.

What if my child needs challenged more than 1 section per week?

Children who want to move at a faster pace can complete the gold and silver section for each week. These optional sections challenge the kids to drill down deeper into the week's biblical topic. Kids who complete the gold and silver sections will do 26 extra Bible studies and learn 104 extra verses. The gold and silver portions are optional.

How often are awards given out?

Kids receive an award after completing every 4 sections.

What if my child gets behind or misses Awana occasionally?

Kids who get behind can catch up during any Awana night during Fast Track. Leaders arrive at 5:40 and can listen to verses prior to Awana. We also have special “catch up” nights to help kids stay on pace. If a child gets behind, let us know and we'll work out a way to help him or her catch up. We'll work with you!

I noticed that you have sections assigned for weeks that Awana doesn't meet. Why is that?

One purpose of Awana is to teach kids to study God's Word on their own and become familiar with a daily time with God. Even though we're not meeting that week, we want the children to continue studying God's Word. The sections will need to be completed in order to receive the book award.

What if my child starts the Awana year late?

Kids who join after September will complete the Start Zone and then jump into the schedule. For example, if the child starts Awana on October 29, he/she will begin with section 1.6.
